BCHS PARKING RULES & GUIDELINES



Overview:

The operation of a motor vehicle on campus is a privilege granted by Burlison ISD. Vehicles requiring a state license are classified as a motor vehicle including cars, trucks, mopeds and motorcycles. All vehicles driven on campus are subject to all local and state traffic laws. A student or employee has full responsibility for the security and content of his or her vehicle. Students, and employees who operate or park a motor vehicle on campus are required to have a valid parking permit decal properly affixed to the vehicle. The person to whom the parking permit is issued is nontransferable. The Burlison Collegiate High School Administration or their designee is given the responsibility of enforcing procedures that provide a safe campus environment for our students.

The privilege of parking a vehicle on campus may be taken away due to violations pertaining to inappropriate behavior or parking violations. Upon arriving at school, students must immediately vacate their cars and the parking lot and enter the school building. Students in the parking lot during the day without a pass will be subject to disciplinary action.

Parking Permits Required for Students:

- 1) A student driving a motor vehicle or motorcycle to school must be a licensed driver;
- 2) Have the required liability insurance coverage and
- 3) The student must register the motor vehicle and obtain a parking permit sticker.

Purchase of Parking Permits:

- 1) Eligible students may purchase an initial parking permit sticker for \$50.00.
- 2) Parking stickers for additional vehicles for student will be \$10.00.
- 3) Students will be required to complete a parking permit form, and
- 4) Show their valid driver's license at time of purchase

Place of Purchase:

- 1) Parking sticker sales will begin August 7th and continue throughout the school year.
- 2) Students must complete, turn in paperwork and pay for parking permit (in the Office) before they start driving on property.

Replacement Parking Stickers:

In the event that another sticker is needed the student must purchase a sticker for \$10.00 in the Office.

Parking Areas for Students:

- 1) Student Parking Lot (located on the Arena side of the school)
- 2) Park in the Green stripes area only
- 3) ***Parking will be first come – first available daily. There will be no assigned parking spots.***

NO Student parking areas:

- 1) Any area that is NOT yellow striped.
Parking maps will be provided at time of purchase.

Fine Amounts:

- 1) 1st violation parking with no parking sticker will be a \$10.00 fine. Purchase sticker ASAP before second violation.
- 2) 2nd violation the student will be called in and charged \$50.00 for the sticker and a \$20.00 fine.
- 3) All other parking violations (Parking Lot Rules) the students will be charged a \$20.00 fine for each violation.
- 4) FINES to be paid in front office

Parking Lot rules:

Parking lot regulations include, but not limited to:

- 10-MPH speed limit on campus at all times
- No parking without a permit displayed in window
- Fully applied to window.
- No parking in more than one parking space.
- PARKING ONLY in the yellow striped areas

Display of Permit

Permit must be **fully affixed** to the window.

Place the sticker on the front window at the bottom, on the passenger side.
